

Larke Peak Climbing - 21 Days

Larkya Peak Climbing trip is not just a Climbing trip. It is a combination of the Manaslu Circuit trek and a peak climbing experience. Mt. Manaslu is the eighth highest Peak in the world height of 8163 meters. Manaslu Circuit trek is one of the most beautiful trek in Nepal which leads through culturally and naturally beautiful villages and the Buddi Gandaki River valley.

During our journey, we have a great opportunity to include Puggen Tal, Pungen Glacier, Pung Gyan Gumpa, and Mount Manaslu Base Camp are great side trips. Also, we will visit the border of the Tiber traditional trading route a long time back connecting with Nepal and Tibet. All these side trips are good preparation for Climb Larkya Peak elevation of 6249 meters.
